



PREMIUM IN-GROUND POOL LINER WARRANTY

Doughboy Vinyl Technologies warrants to the original retail consumer that their in-ground vinyl liner is a product of high-quality material and workmanship. Defects in workmanship or material under this Premium Pool Liner Limited Warranty are comprised of the following: Faulty workmanship in the fabrication of the liner (seams). Doughboy Vinyl Technologies warrants that the pool liner will not leak due to a seam seal delamination when the liner is subjected to normal and customary use. Subject to the conditions set out herein Doughboy Vinyl Technologies agrees, at its option, to replace or repair the pool liner at no charge if there are any defects in the workmanship or the vinyl materials (as described below) within the first two years from the original date of purchase F.O.B. its factory.

The limited warranty determination of repair or replacement shall be solely at the discretion of Doughboy Vinyl Technologies. This limited warranty coverage does not include surface staining, fading of decorative print, or damage resulting from other causes including, but not limited to: improper installation, damage caused by misuse of chemicals, fire, ice damage, improper cleaning, accidents, negligence, misuse, abuse, or acts of God. Irregularities in printing, fading, or tile or pattern alignment are specifically excluded from this limited warranty. Raw materials used in the fabrication of the liner are not manufactured by Doughboy Vinyl Technologies; therefore, any failure due to material defects must be referred to the manufacturer of the raw materials. Doughboy Vinyl Technologies will not be responsible for any damage or defect to the liner which results from insects, animals, floods, acts of God, or from an act or acts of others, and Doughboy Vinyl Technologies shall have no liability to replace or repair any liner that is so damaged. The Limited Warranty shall also not apply to any unauthorized repairs or modifications to the liner, any liners that are sold "as-is," any damages to property (real or personal) during the installation, removal, or repair of the liner. The cost of repair or replacement of the liner for any of the excluded circumstances shall solely be the responsibility of the consumer."

During the initial two years after the date of purchase there shall be NO CHARGE to the original purchaser/consumer for full replacement value of the liner. Thereafter, a charge will be made. This charge will be a percentage of the retail price in effect at the time of replacement or repair. Percentages are based on the length of time from date of purchase. The following schedule sets forth the percentage rate:

Doughboy Vinyl Technologies shall not be responsible for the cost of removal or replacement of any defective liner, nor any other expenses or for damages which might be incurred in such removal and replacement. This limited warranty is enforceable only by the original retail consumer purchaser and applies only to liners purchased for private, residential use only.

THE CONSUMER'S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY UNDER THIS LIMITED WARRANTY SHALL BE LINER REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT AS PROVIDED HEREIN AND DETERMINED AT THE SOLE AND ABSOLUTE DISCRETION OF DOUGHBOY VINYL TECHNOLOGIES. THE CONSUMER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THERE ARE NO WARRANTIES WHICH EXTEND BEYOND THE DESCRIPTION ON THE FACE HEREOF. THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS MADE WITH THE EXPRESS UNDERSTANDING OF THE CONSUMER THAT IT SHALL APPLY IN CONNECTION WITH THE SALE OF THE POOL LINER BY DOUGHBOY VINYL TECHNOLOGIES TO THE CONSUMER AND IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES INCLUDING (BUT NOT LIMITED TO) THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR PARTICULAR PURPOSE. DOUGHBOY VINYL TECHNOLOGIES SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR CONSEQUENTIAL, SPECIAL AND/OR INCIDENTAL EXPENSES OR DAMAGES RESULTING FROM ANY BREACH OF THIS WRITTEN LIMITED WARRANTY OR ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY INCLUDING (BUT NOT LIMITED TO) DAMAGES RESULTING FROM PERSONAL OR BODILY INJURY OR DEATH OR DAMAGES TO, OR LOSS OF USE OF, ANY PROPERTY. THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS TO BE INTERPRETED, ENFORCED AND GOVERNED BY AND UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE. THIS WRITING IS INTENDED BY DOUGHBOY VINYL TECHNOLOGIES AND CONSUMER AS A FINAL AND EXCLUSIVE EXPRESSION OF THEIR AGREEMENT AND NO COURSE OF DEALING OR USAGE OF TRADE OR COURSE OF PERFORMANCE SHALL BE RELEVANT TO EXPLAIN OR SUPPLEMENT ANY TERM USED IN THIS LIMITED WARRANTY.

Essential Maintenance & Protection Standards

THE PH CHECK

pH is the measure of acidity/basicity level in your pool. A proper pH level (7.2 to 7.6) not only increases human comfort, but also helps chlorine cleans your pool better, because chlorine needs a certain pH level to kill bacteria and algae.

THE TOTAL ALKALINITY CHECK

Your water test kit or your dealer's test will show a total alkalinity reading. Simply put, it's the ability of your pool water to counteract changes in the pH level. Ideally, the total alkalinity level should be at 80-120 ppm.

OTHER SAFETY CHECKS

Allow each chemical to circulate throughout the pool before adding a second chemical. Certain combinations of chemicals at a high concentration can cause bleaching of the liner. Test for the presence of dissolved metals, because they may directly stain the vinyl liner or combine with calcium hardness to form discolored deposits. Each Doughboy Vinyl Technologies Pool Liner has a special transparent topcoat that protects the print pattern from abrasion and soil adhesion. To maintain its effectiveness, avoid using abrasive cleaning agents or cleaning aids.

THE WATER STABILIZATION CHECK

All vinyl pools must be routinely stabilized with cyanuric acid in a range between 25 ppm and 50 ppm. A level of less than 50 ppm combined with a pH level of less than 7.0 and/or a chlorine level higher than 3.0 ppm can destroy the liner.

THE CALCIUM HARDNESS CHECK

Calcium levels should be kept at a minimum level of 200 ppm to avoid corrosive conditions. Calcium levels over 500 ppm may cause problems such as cloudy water or scaling on the liner surface.

CLOSING THE POOL

At the end of the pool season, Adjust the water level to the dealer's recommended level. Should you have any questions about your pool, call your dealer - he's your pool professional. Test the pool water and balance. NEVER close a pool without circulating the pool water for several hours after the final additions of chemicals. Chlorine may settle in the deep end and bleach the liner if not allowed to blend with the pool water. Clean and vacuum the pool from top to bottom. Use a proper-fitting winter pool cover, tightly sealed around the perimeter of the pool. It will prevent the accumulation of debris such as leaves and insects during the winter.
